Re: Design Right Lawsuit in Japan

We, Wacom Co., Ltd. have initiated a lawsuit against Princeton Technology Corporation, (Princeton Technology) for the infringement of its own Japanese design rights by tablet and pen being imported and sold in Japan. Please refer to the details below.

1. Plaintiff and Defendant:

2. Date of Filing and Court:

Date of Filing: February 22, 2011

Court: Tokyo District Court

3. Remedy Sought By Wacom:

Preliminary Injunction against the importation and sale of the "Princeton Sirius Tablet" (Model No. PTB-S2BK) by Princeton Technology, namely tablet. Wacom alleges infringing the following i) and ii) Japanese design rights and pen therefor Wacom alleges infringing the following iii) Japanese design right;

- i) Design Right Registration No.1372732
- ii) Design Right Registration No.1372733
- iii) Design Right Registration No.1238477

4. Background of Lawsuit:

Wacom has been selling "Intuos 4" tablet for professional use as one of its main products. Wacom alleges that the above tablet and pen therefore which Princeton Technology imports and sells in Japan infringes on its own Japanese design rights and has filed a request for granting a preliminary injunction to immediately stop such importation and sale by Princeton Technology.
