Re: Wacom Operations Affected by Tohoku Pacific Earthquake (3)

Wacom Co., Ltd. updated its status on the influence of the Tohoku Pacific Earthquake which struck on March 11, 2011 and was announced on March 16, 2011 and on March 29, 2011 we updated the status. Please refer to the details below. (Underlined parts are modified.)

1. Status of damage:

i) Employees working at domestic site

(No change) All employees are currently reported to be safe.

ii) Domestic site

(No change) While the administration building and factory building headquarters (Kazo-shi, Saitama Prefecture) were partially damaged, we have resumed our normal operations. No damage in the Tokyo branch or in each of our domestic offices (Nagoya, Osaka, Fukuoka) have been recognized.

2. Influence on the production activity

Most of the production facilities are overseas and our domestic factory has already resumed its normal operations. We have already confirmed that there are no difficulties in our production activity until May. Outside influences which include parts suppliers and partners' operations near the circumference of the ruined area, the power supply situation and systems of distribution, etc. are expected to influence production activity after that. The influence on production activities will be kept to a minimum by having close cooperation with our suppliers and partners.

3. About compensating for the blackout

Although rolling blackouts are not probable for the present, Wacom copes with any blackouts by using private electric generators and having flexible work hours. This secures enough electrical power for our facilities except for air-conditioners. Even at blackout times there are no problems foreseen with our production activities.

4. Influence on the latest forecast:

(No change) The impact of the earthquake on our financial performance is currently being evaluated. We intend to make an announcement promptly should we foresee significant impact to our business.

Wacom expresses its deepest sympathies for those affected by the disaster and sincerely hopes for a quick recovery.
